1. The competition will be held under Swim England laws, Swim England Technical Rules of Swimming and these Promoter's conditions. Enfield Swim Squad will liaise with the pool operators regarding COVID and COVID safety management by the pool operators, in addition to any rules and regulations in place by the Government at the date of this meet. Whilst plans are in place for Enfield Swim Squad to produce a document indicating necessary protocols, this will be published as soon as possible, but in the current pandemic, may be subject to change. All participants will be required to agree to this as part of the opt into this meet.
2. The Meet has been licensed at Level 4 by Swim England, license no 4LR231040. This gala is classed as a low level competition. All entries must be no faster than the upper limit qualifying times as per the attached table. The Meet will be open to Enfield Swim Squad and up to seven clubs invited by the promoter. The closing date is midnight on Friday, 27th May 2023 or sooner if the meet is oversubscribed. Confirmation of accepted entries will be returned as soon as possible after this date and following receipt of a completed summary sheet and payment.
3. Ages as on the last day of the meet – 17th June 2023.
4. The pool is 25m long with 8 lanes, anti-wave lane ropes and Colorado electronic timing system in operation. The pool depth is 1.8m at the start end of the pool and 1m at the turn end.
5. In the interests of time, 'over the top' starts may be operated at the discretion of the referee.
6. An electronic entry system will be operated at this meet. Swimmers must withdraw using the appropriate form at the relevant desk no later than 15 minutes prior to the start of each warm up.
7. Swimmers must report to the clerks of the course when instructed to do so. Any competitor not reporting in time may be excluded.
8. Swimmers must be Swim England registered at Club Train or Club Compete (category 1 or 2) and have a Swim England registration number and belong to an affiliated club.

Closing Date: Friday, 26th May 2023 (or sooner if full)



9. All events will be swum as combined age groups and seeded slowest to fastest irrespective of age.
10. Time trials may be available to swimmers at the promoter's discretion and dependent upon space and will incur a fee of £10 payable before the race takes place. All time trials will be swum in the first heat. They will not be eligible for medals. No refunds will be given except where entries are rejected.
11. The entry fee will be £6.00 per event for all events (this includes the SWIM ENGLAND's 20p levy). No refunds will be given except where entries are rejected. Clubs with more than 5 swimmers should enter electronically by using Hy-Tek's Team Manager Software. This can be downloaded from Hy-Tek's website. Please complete the electronic entry summary form (<https://forms.gle/PUFtQYhD8Z8FGbcN7>) and submit the Hy-Tek entry file to essopenmeets@enfieldswimsquad.org. Payments must be made when the form is submitted to: Enfield Swim Squad, HSBC, sort code 40-22-34, account number 61471260. Entry times must be 25m pool times. Any club with 10 or more swimmers is requested to provide a SWIM ENGLAND registered official (J1, J2, J2S, TK, Referee).
12. Coaches passes are available at a cost of £5 each to a maximum of 4 per team. Swim England Guidelines state that the ratio of swimmers to "minders" should be 10:1. No one will be allowed on poolside without a pass.
13. Spectator entry will be £7 per person for the day.
14. Entries should be emailed to essopenmeets@enfieldswimsquad.org. The entry summary should be submitted electronically (<https://forms.gle/PUFtQYhD8Z8FGbcN7>). The closing date is midnight, Friday, 26th May 2023, or sooner if full; entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. All entry forms must be fully and correctly completed, otherwise they may be rejected. Electronic entries are mandatory for clubs with more than 5 attending swimmers, unless arranged otherwise by prior agreement of the promoter. Clubs sending more than 5 paper entries will be required to pay a £10 administration fee. The Hy-Tek Team Manager entry file is available from the promoter on request.
15. Withdrawals before the day of the event will only be accepted up until 15th June 2023. Any withdrawals after this date must be made at the commencement of the warm-up of each session in which the event is to be withdrawn at the latest.
16. The age groups are 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14. Ages as on the day of the meet – 17th June 2023
17. Awards will be given to the first 3 in each age group in each event on a HDW basis. Points will be awarded to the top 6 swimmers in each age group and an award will be given to the top boy and top girl (exhibition swims and/or TTs will contribute to the top club trophy) The Charlie Farnsbarns trophy will be awarded to the top visiting club based on the number of points awarded divided by the number of swimmers entered by the club (withdrawals on the day will still be included in the calculation). The trophy must be returned to Enfield Swim Squad before next year's competition.
18. The events are:
 - a. 50m all four strokes - All age groups
 - b. 100m Individual Medley - All age groups
 - c. 12 x 25m Mixed Relay - 1 boy and girl from the following age groups: 8/9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14.
19. A secondary stroke will be available at this Meet.

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20. Results will be available on the club website as soon as practicable after the meet. A full set of results will be sent by email to all clubs. **Please ensure a correct email address is provided to us with your entries.** The personal information supplied with your entry will be retained securely and will only be used for the legitimate purposes of running the event. This data will be shared by form of results with Swim England (Rankings) and the clubs who have entered the meet. A full copy of the results will be published on the website after the meet. Please be aware that links from our website may take you to external websites that are not covered by our policies. Please ensure that you review their privacy policies before any data is submitted. If any persons want to exercise their right to erasure or processing of their personal data they will need to make a written request to the promoter.
21. All participants and spectators must observe all safety precautions in operation at the pool and follow instructions of pool staff and the Enfield Swim Squad management team. Prior to leaving poolside, swimmers must dry off and put on appropriate clothing and footwear. No swimmers will be allowed into the spectator area or the main entrance foyer area unless they have complied with this requirement.
22. By submitting their entries, swimmers accept these conditions in full. Failure to comply with any condition may result in suspension from the competition and forfeiture of any fee paid. The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any competitor or spectator to any session.
23. **Video Recording/Photography/Mobile Telephones:** All photography or video recording must fall within the guidelines on photography and video recording set out by [Wavepower](#). It is requested that all mobile telephones are switched off or turned to silent during the competition and that there is no flash photography at the start of each event. There may be a designated official videographer/photographer.
24. **No photography or filming of any kind is permitted in the changing rooms or village. Anyone found contravening this requirement will be required to leave the facility with immediate effect and without refund.**
25. All persons attending the competition are advised to exercise reasonable care when taking photos or video, particularly with regards to the sharing of images on social media. [Wavepower](#) guidance should be followed at all times.
26. No photography by competitors should take place at the venue at any time during the meet - this includes from admittance into the centre **and** until they have left the building.
27. Safeguarding concerns should be reported to the Promoter. If the concerns relate to conduct of the Promoter, a report should be made to the Chairman and Welfare Officer of Enfield Swim Squad.
28. Enfield Swim Squad reserves the right to amend these Conditions, without prior notice, to ensure the smooth running of the meet. For any matters not covered by these Conditions, the promoter will make any decisions they deem necessary to provide for the satisfactory running of the competition. By submitting an entry, participants are deemed to have agreed to such decisions.
29. All visiting clubs must ensure that team managers/coaches and officials comply with [Wavepower](#).
